Respect each other and the equipment in the science room. Do not interfere with the learning of any student at any given time.

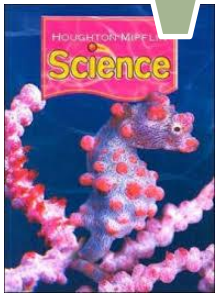

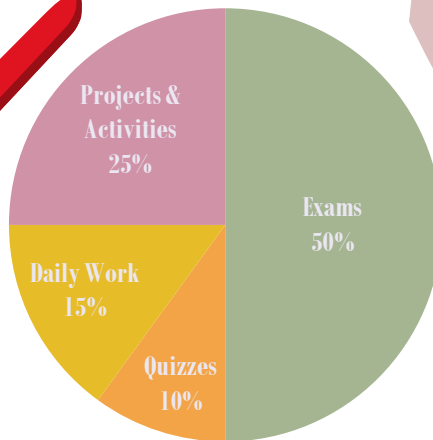
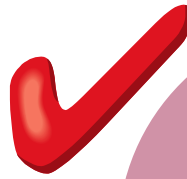
